



### **Grand Caraïbe Guadeloupe 2026 – General Information**

The Regional Equestrian Committee of Guadeloupe and La Martingale Equestrian Centre invite you to the 2026 edition of the Grand Caraïbe. This competition will bring together Martinique, Guadeloupe, French Guyana, Suriname as well as special guests Jamaica, Bermuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Antigua and the Cayman Islands.

**Venue:** La Martingale Equestrian Centre, 97-122 Baie-Mahault, Guadeloupe

#### **Competition: 3 Levels**

Espoir: 85 cm/barrage 90 cm – 1 rider per delegation

Elite: 95 cm/barrage 100 – 2 riders per delegation

Grand Prix 105 cm/barrage 110 cm – 1 rider per delegation

#### **Program:**

Competition Dates: April 30 – May 3. Exact program tbd.

Estimated travel dates: April 28 – May 4 (subject to change)

**Costs:** Athletes are responsible for the following costs: (\*these specifics are subject to change)

- Coaching fee - \$800/day, to be divided amongst athletes
- Coach airfare – to be divided amongst athletes
- Chef D'Équipe airfare and accommodation – to be divided amongst athletes
- Federation administrative fee - \$300 per athlete
- Accommodation fee - €200 payable to organizing committee via wire transfer in advance \*
- Round trip airfare and baggage costs
- Taxi transfers if applicable
- Meals (Breakfast, lunch and dinner)

The following are subsidized by the Federation:

- Accommodation for COACHES ONLY (double occupancy per room)
- Horse Rental Fees
- Competition Entry Fees
