Competition: 2 Levels

Espoir: 75-85 cm/Jump off max 90 cm

Elite: 90 - 100 cm/Jump off max 1.05m

Competition Dates: July 2-5. Exact program tbd.

Estimated travel dates: July 1-6 (subject to change)

Costs: Athletes are responsible for the following costs: (*these specifics are subject to change)

- Coaching fee - \$800/day, to be divided amongst athletes
- Coach airfare – to be divided amongst athletes
- Federation administrative fee - \$300 per athlete
- Accommodation fee – to be determined
- Round trip airfare and baggage costs
- Taxi transfers if applicable
- Meals (Breakfast, lunch and dinner)

The following are subsidized by the Federation:

- Accommodation for COACHES ONLY (double occupancy per room)
- Horse Rental Fees
- Competition Entry Fees
