# World Clubs Tournament



The World Clubs Tournament is an international friendly competition aimed at equestrian clubs from all regions of the world and their riders, who are beginners in competition and ride equestrian club horses. This event takes place during the Generali Open de France Clubs, a large sporting and family gathering held in July at the Parc équestre fédéral in Lamotte-Beuvron (France). Beyond enjoyment and sport, this competition is intended to be a special opportunity for meeting and exchange.



## ► Concept

Teams of three or four riders represent clubs from different nations and compete in two show jumping events at the club level. A team ranking is established at the end of this competition.

## ► Objectives

The World Clubs Tournament is a friendly event where participants from different nations meet, compete, and exchange ideas about their equestrian culture. This event also allows young riders **to experience the joy of international competition**, particularly with the Nations Parade at the opening of the competition.

The World Clubs Tournament is also an opportunity for federation representatives and team leaders to discover the French system of equestrian development and competition.



# Generali Open de France

## ► The Generali Open de France Clubs: a unique experience

The World Clubs Tournament takes place annually at the Parc équestre fédéral in Lamotte-Beuvron (France) during the **Generali Open de France Clubs, "GOF Clubs", the French Championships for equestrian club riders**, which is one of the largest equestrian gatherings in the world. In addition to its impressive scale, with over 5000 riders and 5000 ponies and horses coming together for a week to represent more than a thousand clubs, this event features around twenty equestrian disciplines. It is in an atmosphere dedicated to horses, riders, and sport that the various teams of the World Clubs Tournament compete.

## ► Previous editions

The World Clubs Tournament has been held since 2004 and has welcomed more than 34 nations. Teams from all corners of the world have competed, including Algeria, Germany, Belgium, Chile, China, South Korea, Ivory Coast, Great Britain, Italy, India, Mauritius, Madagascar, Malta, Senegal, Togo, Turkey, and more.
